Two Richmond Boxers to Stand Off in Coquitlam

RICHMOND, BC (December 17, 2008) – This December, Canadian boxers Louis Sargeant and Ralph (Junior) Moar will step into the ring a stone's throw from their Richmond homes. The two fighters will square off at Rumble at the Red in a six-round bout at the Red Robinson Show Theatre in Coquitlam.

"I like fighting close to home," says Sargeant, who recently opened Louis Sargeant Fitness, a personal training business in Richmond BC. "All the people I train are always bugging me to fight in Canada so they can come watch. Now that I have that chance, I plan to put on a good show." In a career that spans over a decade, Sargeant (9-11-2) has only fought five times on Canadian soil.

For Moar, a former Canadian middleweight amateur champion, it's nothing new. His entire professional career (4-2) has been in Canada, not to mention the dozens of times he fought in the ring to achieve his former title. Moar recently re-entered the professional boxing arena after serving a four-year prison sentence for his involvement in a gang shooting.

Rumble at the Red happens on Saturday, Dec. 27 at 7 p.m. in the Red Robinson Show Theatre. In addition to the fight between Sargeant and Moar, there will six other bouts featuring several other Canadian boxers. Tickets prices range from \$39 to \$239.
